## TRINITY CAPITAL CAMPAIGN NEWS

The Capital Campaign Committee has interviewed several candidates for the role of consultant to the committee, and has chosen Jim Sheppard of Generis in Atlanta, GA (http://generis.com/our-people/jim-sheppard/). He and his firm are very experienced in church fundraising, and he is especially knowledgeable about The Woodlands as he has worked several times with Woodlands Methodist. His first job is to help the committee assess the potential for the campaign, which involves a mixture of personal interviews and a survey of the entire parish. We hope to complete this by the end of the year and then use that data to kick-off the formal campaign in early 2015. Once the process timeline is established the Committee will communicate it to the parish. This is an exciting time for Trinity as we move toward fulfilling our master plan.

# TRINITY EPISCOPAL DAY SCHOOL

Trinity Episcopal Day School is beginning its thirteenth year as part of Trinity Episcopal Church! Ours is a developmental preschool program serving children ages 18 months-4 years. Our classes meet for the morning preschool program from 8:45 AM-12:00 PM and we offer an optional extended day until 2:00. TEDS is a state licensed facility and we are in our 6th year of accreditation by The Southwestern Association of Episcopal Schools. TEDS is governed by a school board that has responsibility for fiduciary oversight and general guidance to the school administration. Each day of attendance, children in the three and four year old classes attend Chapel with Trinity Clergy and Staff. Currently, TEDS has several openings in the 18 month, 2 and 3 year old classes.
