STATIONS OF THE CROSS

The Stations of the Cross is a traditional liturgical devotion commemorating the last day of Jesus' life. The devotion originated with pilgrims in Jerusalem retracing the traditional steps Jesus is believed to have followed on Good Friday. Since not all Christians could make pilgrimages to Jerusalem, however, the custom arose of replicating the devotion in congregational and individual settings, often with images or carvings on the walls of a church to commemorate each of the traditional 14 stations (or stops) on the Way of the Cross.

A Verger Lost, A Verger Gained

I am sad to announce that verger John McKinley and his wife, Stacey, are moving to Tyler sometime in February to be near their son. John has served Trinity faithfully and well in many ways. As a verger, he has been my assistant in addition to holding down normal verger duties. John will be missed. I am happy to announce that Richard Mayer has accepted Fr. Sevick's call to join the Ministry of Vergers. His training started in November, and you will see him in a training assignment as Processional Verger during the February 1st services. Richard's investiture will take place on Sunday, February 15, during the 11:00 AM service, with reception to follow in Butler Fellowship Hall. Those of you fairly new to Trinity may not know exactly what a verger is. The role of Verger originated in the middle ages. Vergers were men who led priestly processions through dirt streets to the church and who carried a mace to clear the way. Today they are lay assistants to the rector. They still have the ceremonial role of leading processions. Instead of a mace, they carry a staff, called a verge, as a symbol of their office. A verger's primary role is one of "stage manager" for the services. Vergers worry about the physical aspects of the service so that the clergy can concentrate on the liturgy. They help plan special services, sometimes fill in as lay Eucharistic minister or acolyte server and do other bidding of the rector. Vergers are called by the rector, and theirs is a long term commitment.
