

"U.S. Poverty Myths"

MYTH: All U.S. children have equal opportunities in school.

THE REALITY: *Children born poor, at low birth weight, without health coverage, and who start school not ready to learn often fall behind and drop out. *Teachers in high poverty schools are more likely to have less experience, less training, and fewer advanced degrees than teachers in low poverty schools. *22 percent of children who have lived in poverty do not graduate from high school, compared with 6 percent of those who have never been poor. *32 percent of students who spent more than half of their childhoods in poverty do not graduate. (Children's Defense Fund, 2010; Annie E. Casey Foundation, 2012)
