#### Trinity Episcopal Day School News

Trinity Episcopal Day School (TEDS) is a licensed and accredited school with classes for 18 month olds through Kindergarten. Preschool hours are 8:45-12:00 and vary by day depending on age group, with an extended day until 2:00 available by reservation. Kindergarten hours are 8:45-2:00 Monday through Thursday and 8:45-12:00 on Friday. Our staff is experienced in an early childhood setting, have educational requirements commensurate with the demands of each age group, and complete a minimum of twenty-four hours of continuing education each year. In addition, there is a requirement of attendance in CPR/First Aid and Safeguarding God's Children classes at regular intervals throughout their employment. Our educational focus reflects each area of growth: academic, social, emotional, physical and spiritual. Curriculum is planned, reviewed, evaluated and adjusted to offer the children an engaging, exciting opportunity to expand their abilities in every area, working at their own pace in a group setting that is both encouraging and challenging. Our preschool and Kindergarten curriculum meets or exceeds the C.I.S.D. standards and bestpractice. The TEDS children ages three through six attend Chapel each morning and all classes participate in on-going monthly outreach activities as part of the Episcopal identity of the program. We have an active Parents' Association and School Board, empowered to support and promote the program at TEDS, through oversight, fund-raising and active, personal involvement. The children benefit greatly from their assistance. We hope you will investigate, visit and enjoy learning about the school with which your parish is affiliated. At the present time there are limited openings in several age groups, especially the four year old classes. We would love for you and your child to join us here at TEDS.
