

# FINANCIALS AT A GLANCE

Through the end of September 2013, Trinity's giving is \$76,628 behind our year-to-date budget. As a result, church and ministry operations are short \$66,082.

Here are the numbers as of September 30th:

Budgeted Giving \$1,113,750/Actual Giving \$1,037,122. YTD Revenue \$1,333,446/YTD Expenses = \$1,399,528 A big "thanks" to those who caught-up after the summer vacation season, as we have seen the YTD financial condition improves slightly during the past month. Through your faithful stewardship reflecting God's

generosity, our ministries can continue to flourish!
