FINANCIALS AT A GLANCE

Through the end of October 2013, Trinity's financial picture has not improved. Our giving is \$125,207 behind our year-to-date budget with only 2 months to catch up. As a result, church and ministry operations are short \$77,504. Here are the numbers as of October 31st: Budgeted Giving = \$1,214,454 vs. Actual Giving = \$1,112,293 YTD Revenue = \$1,477,797 vs. YTD Expenses = \$1,555,301. A big "thanks" to those who caught-up on their giving following our call last month, others need to do the same. It is only through your faithful stewardship reflecting God's generosity that our ministries will continue to flourish at Trinity!
