The 8:45 AM Sunday School Class will be starting a new series. We will be studying a book titled *The Anglican Vision* by James E. Griffiss. In this first volume to the New Church's Teaching Series Griffiss provides an introduction to the Anglican tradition. He focuses especially on Anglicanism's ability to hold together theological continuity (especially the emphasis on the Incarnation) with social and cultural change. Griffiss shows how the distinctive Anglican approach has been lived out in its history, spirituality, mission, worship, and approach to Scripture. Throughout, the book stresses the place of Anglicanism in the late twentieth century and its ability to be both flexible and traditional in rapidly changing cultures. This class meets every Sunday in the Wesley Room for prayer, fellowship, and study.
