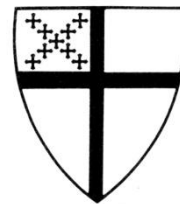

"Outreach Idea for the Week"

Myth: No one goes hungry in America.

The Reality: One in six Americans lives in a household that is "food insecure" meaning that in any given month, they will be out of money, out of food, and forced to miss meals or seek assistance to feed themselves. Nationally, more than 50 MILLION Americans were food insecure in 2011 - a 39% increase from 2007. Among the hungry are nearly 17 MILLION children. (U.S. Department of Agriculture, 2012)
